"This is my Scrappy Applique goat from the January CVQ workshop.

The technique is easy and a lot of fun. I have two more patterns and can't wait to get started on those."

"Size: 16 x 25

Pattern: Vino, by Laura Heine

Fabrics: mostly pulled from my stash, but purchased 2-3 FQs

Quilting: 1/4" straight lines through everything, Superior Mono Poly on top, Masterpiece in bobbin

Technique: background is pieced (just 2 pieces, sky & cork table), fused collage with *steam a seam 2* on the back of all pieces, wine bottle and wine glass built on a silicone mat then moved to background."

"Started this as an improvisational design using a purchased panel.


I split the panel and added the gold strips, then couched on the variegated yarn.

I added the sea green flange, black border and backing, and then "artistically" outline quilted it. Approximately 16" x 22".

Finished in February 2023."
