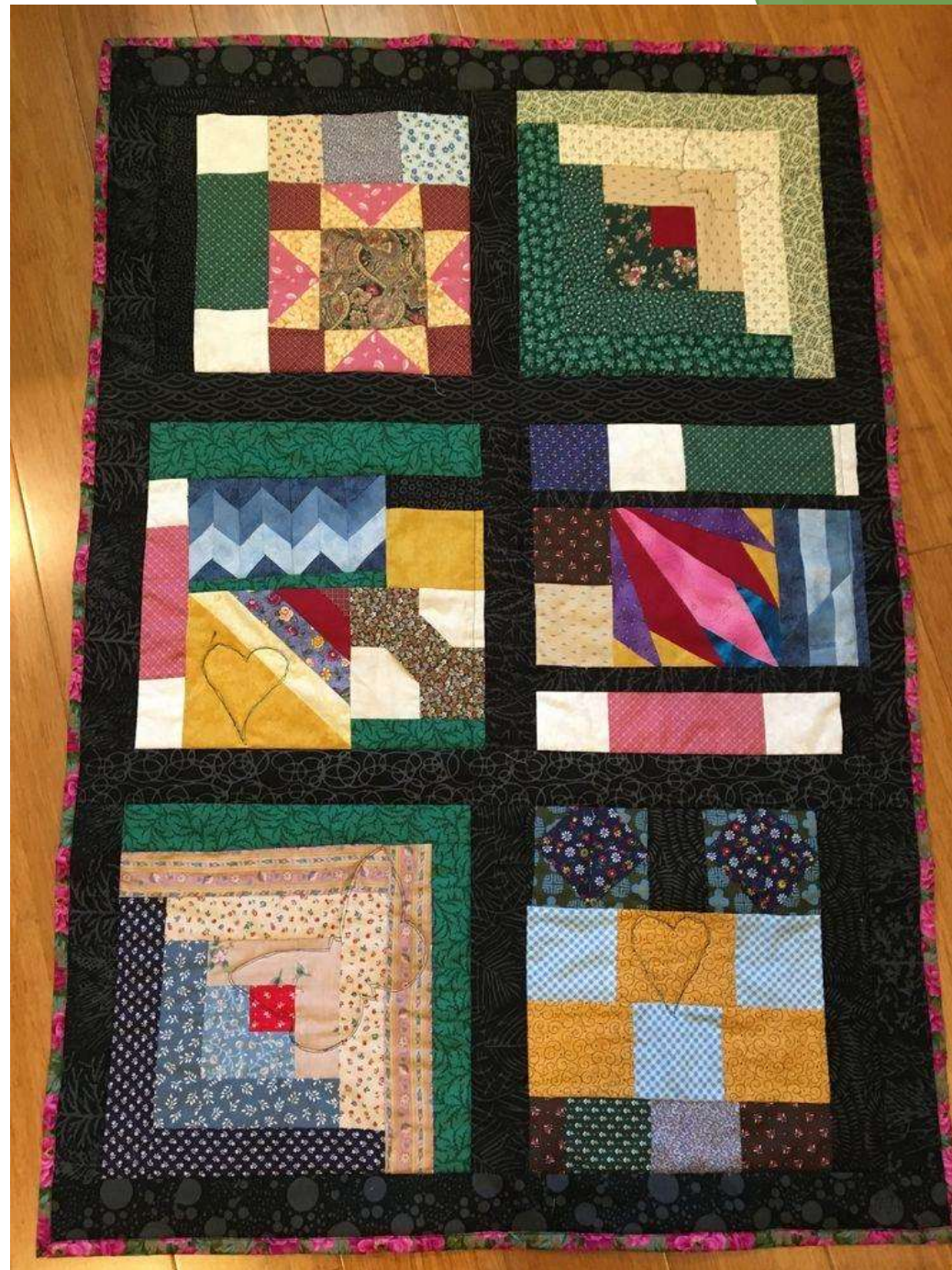
Marty H.

The all-over quilting was done by a longarmer friend here in TX.



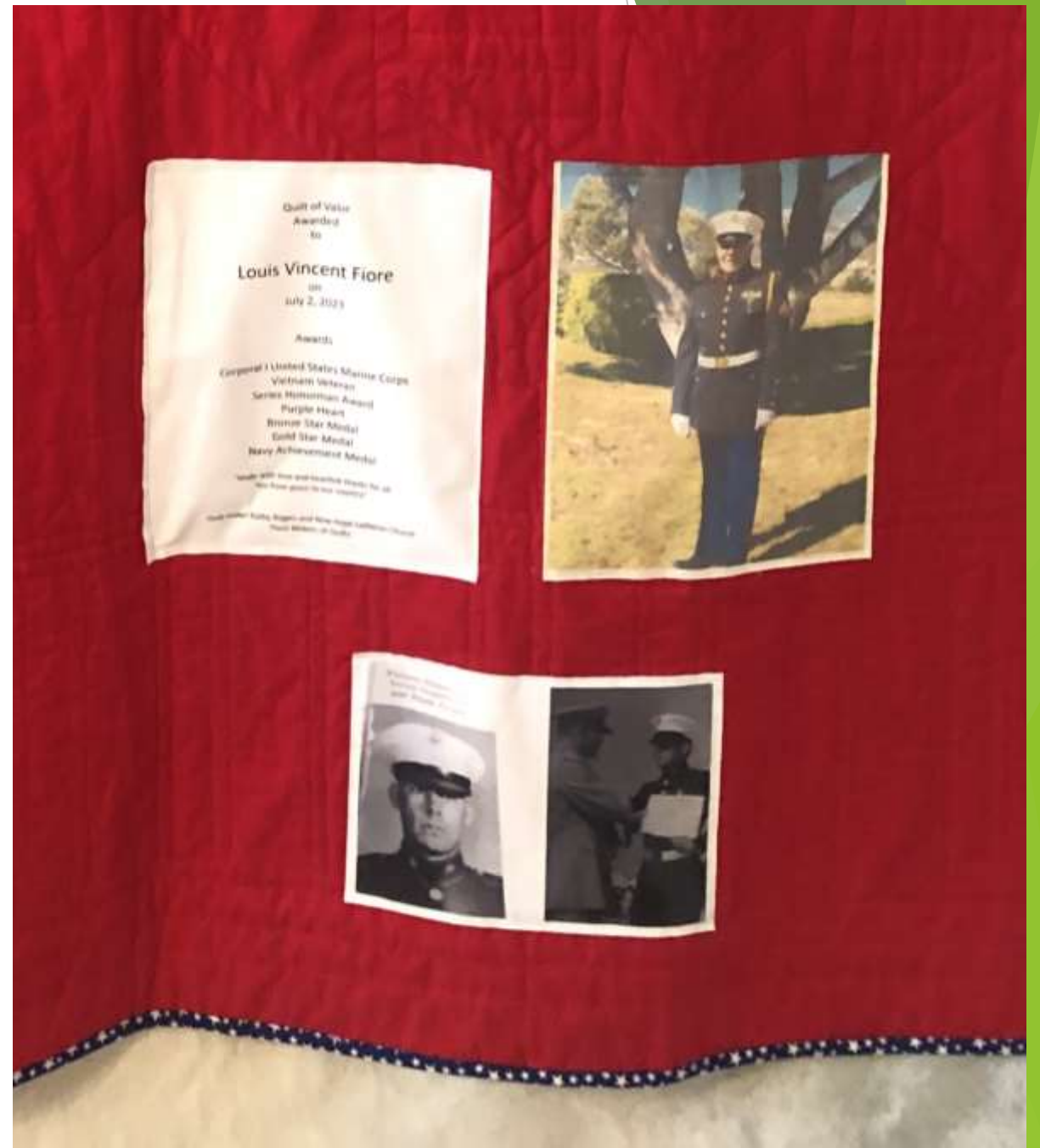
